Home stay accommodations: Students live with a local Chilliwack family and experience Canadian family life and culture.

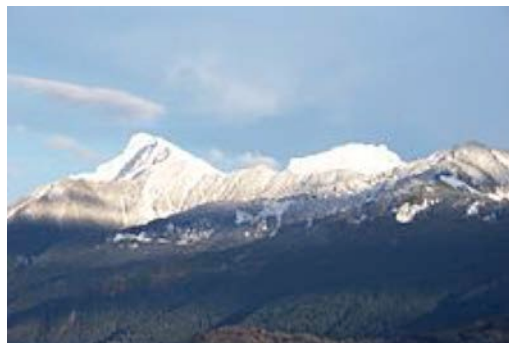
